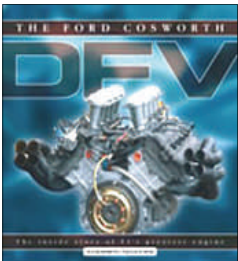
## COSWORTH & FORD: THE ROAD CARS

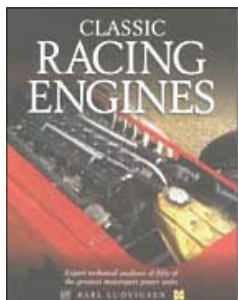


## THE FORD COSWORTH DFV: The Inside Story of F1's Greatest Engine

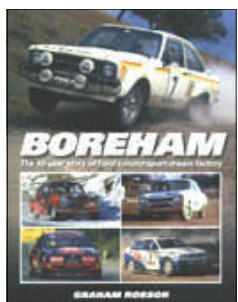

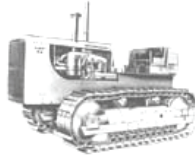
