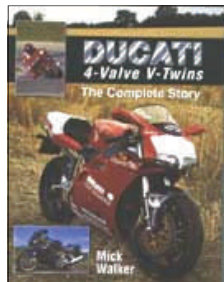
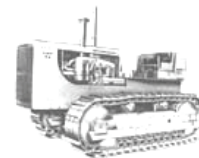

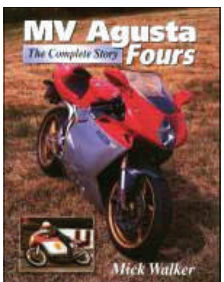
DUCATI 4-VALVE V-TWINS - THE COMPLETE STORY

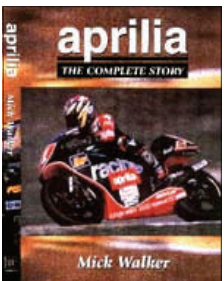
LAVERDA TWINS & TRIPLES - THE COMPLETE STORY

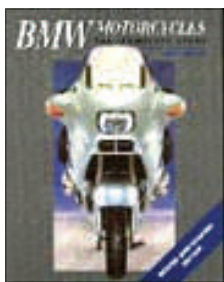

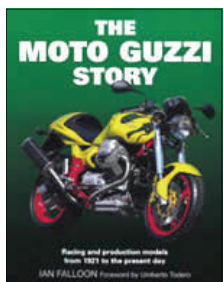

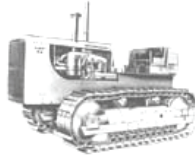
