THE BEST JOB EVER

Ford tractor conversion specialist County Commercial Cars of Fleet in Hampshire was at the peak of its powers when John Hull joined the company as a field test driver and tractor development engineer in 1967, having previously worked for a Fordson tractor dealership in Berkshire. Promoted to chief tractor demonstrator in 1970, John travelled all over the world demonstrating the company's four-wheel drive tractors. His autobiography not only provides a rare insight into what it was like to work for the world's best-known manufacturer of Ford tractor conversions, but also charts the development and evolution of its machines over the 16-year period 1967-83.

The Best Job Ever contains many previously unseen archive photographs of County's best-known tractors - from the four-wheel drive 754 and 1124 models of the late 1960s to the iconic 1884 flagship of the early 80s. There are also chapters on County's innovative Forward Control tractors, used for a wide range of applications, plus its unequal four-wheel drives, tractors for industrial applications, specialist vehicles, including the 4WD Transit, & much more.

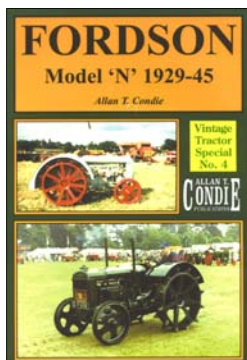

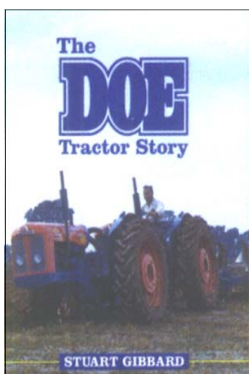
The Story of County, Doe, Northrop, Chaseside, Muir-Hill, Matbro & Bray

County, Doe, Chaseside, Muir-Hill, Matbro and Bray were all well-known British companies and leaders in their own fields of engineering design and innovation, each producing successful ranges of agricultural, earthmoving or construction machinery. Linked by their extensive use of the Ford tractor skid unit as a basis for their machines, these companies also pioneered the development of the four-wheel-drive agricultural tractor in Britain.

Stuart Gibbard gives details of all the main models and machines of these manufacturers. He also brings the firms alive by chronicling their fortunes over a number of years, tracing company histories from the turn of the century to the present day. He discusses many of the personalities involved as well. He also mentions many of the lesser-known Ford tractor conversions and explains why the Ford tractor became so popular with the specialist equipment manufacturers. Other makes of tractor skid besides Ford are included where necessary to complete the story which deals not only with agricultural tractors but also with commercial vehicles, earthmoving and construction equipment, both vintage and modern. This book is invaluable for Ford tractor researchers.

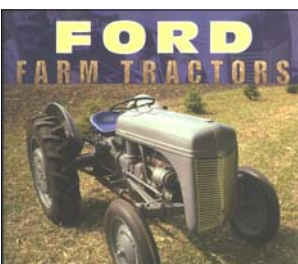
THE DOE TRACTOR STORY

The Doe Triple D became a legend in its own lifetime. With its two engines, four-wheel drive and an articulation of nearly 90 degrees, it was one of the most unorthodox tractors ever built. A very successful machine in its time, it has remained a firm favourite among tractor enthusiasts everywhere. This highly illustrated account tells the full story of this remarkable tractor and the company that manufactured it. The rise of Ernest Doe & Sons from a humble village blacksmith's shop to the largest machinery retail organisation in East Anglia is traced in detail with full coverage given to the machines it made.

Stuart Gibbard has unearthed a wealth of new information and many new photographs to make this one of the most complete accounts ever written on Doe tractors. It follows the development of the Triple D through the 130 and 150 models to the six-cylinder 5100 that marked the end of Doe tractor production.

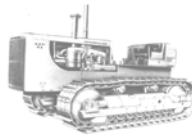
